Instead, it will evaluate infrastructure projects according to standards set by a steering committee of government agencies, development finance institutions and the private sector.

A \$537 million funding package to increase home care packages, reduce chemical restraints, and get younger people out of residential aged care was announced on Monday by prime minister Scott Morrison.




